## The Anderton Centre

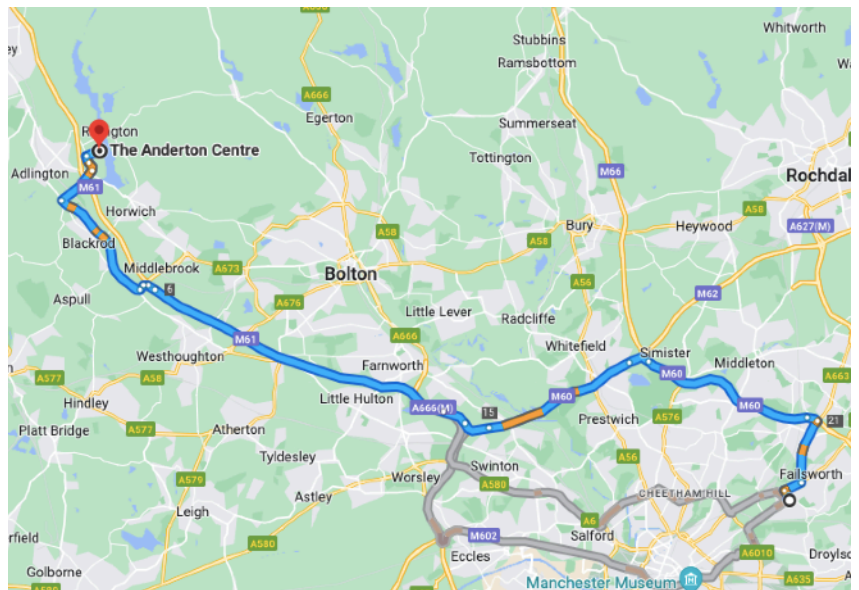

## **Accommodation and Facilities**



### **Bedrooms**

We have 20 en-suite bedrooms under a single roof that sleep a maximum of 70, across three accommodation areas. We pride ourselves on our balanced and nutritious home-cooked food provided in our dining room.

Pike and Woodland View, are within the main building. Both have break-out / lounge areas to enjoy when not on activity. The Centre has a nominated on-site night porter to support any issues during your stay.

## Cost

**The full cost of the trip is £5720, which is £178 per pupil. This cost covers:**

- Coach travel to and from the centre
- 2 nights accommodation
- Fully catered from Friday tea time with all food and drink provided
- Kit (the children will only need to bring old clothing) and equipment provided
- Fully trained Outdoor Instructors
- 3 days of activities

We are very aware that families have different financial pressures and that many of you will have further challenges due to the rise in the cost of living and the after-effects of COVID-19. As this trip covers part of the National Curriculum, it is extremely important that all children attend. If there are any concerns regarding the cost of the trip, please contact Mrs. Flatman and we can discuss support on an individual basis.

We want to ensure that we give families enough notice, as we are aware that the cost of the trip is higher than a typical day trip. Any payments can start being made via the Parent Portal on Arbor from now, which allows families the flexibility of making contributions in instalments, as and when allows.

**By the 30th September 2023**, we do ask for a deposit of £20 as confirmation that your child will be attending the trip, as well as a **completed permission and medical information form** (via a Google form).
